

21ST CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTER PROGRAMS



Highlights from 2018-19 Evaluation

- ▶ Over 4,100 program participants, of which there were 1,336 regular attendees*
- ▶ 82% of regular attendees at the Elementary, Middle and High School levels improved in their MAP Mathematics RIT scores.
- ▶ 72% of regular attendees demonstrating improvement in MAP Reading scores.
- ▶ Across the 4 grant cohorts, the greatest improvement of expected-level achievement from fall to spring occurred at the middle and high school level.
- ▶ Over 74% of regularly attending students who were not proficient, improved to proficient or above on Iowa Assessments.

*Regular attendee is a student who attended 30 or more days of 21st CCLC summer, before and/or after school programs.
